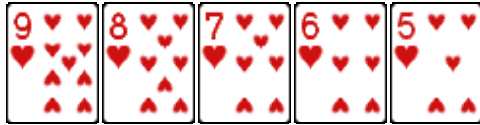

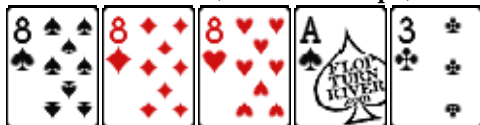

Hold'em Highlights

The Deal

- The dealer button rotates around the table to designate the dealer for each hand
 1. Deal 2 cards face down to each player
 2. Round of betting
 3. Burn a card; deal 3 community cards face up ("the flop")
 4. Round of betting
 5. Burn a card; deal 4th community card face up ("the turn")
 6. Round of betting
 7. Burn a card; deal 5th card face up ("the river")
 8. Round of betting
 9. Show cards – best five cards win

Betting

- Minimum bet is the big blind
- Minimum raise is the previous raise amount
- Check raising is allowed
- No string bets – betting in multiple motions without declaring your bet amount
- Do not splash the pot – place your bet in front of you. Bets are pushed into the pot when the betting round is complete.

Re-buys/Add-ons

- Re-buys will get you \$800 in chips
- Unlimited re-buys are available to players with chip stacks of \$200 or less during the first five rounds
- Players may not re-buy during a hand
- Add-ons will get you \$2,000 in chips
- Add-ons are available to all players one time only at the break

Odds & Ends

- No table talk – do not call the possible hands on the table
- One player per hand – no help from the rail
- Players moved to a new table may be moved into the big blind. New players cannot move into the small blind or button position. In this case, the player must sit out until the button passes to the player just past the new player.
- The Tournament Director will make all decisions for the good of the game. Tournament Director decisions are final.

Chip Values
